**Provide support to victims of ragging.**



## **BE INFORMED:**

Understand what constitutes ragging and its consequences



## **SPEAK UP:**

Report any incidents of ragging you witness or experience

## **SUPPORT PEERS:**

Offer support to those who may be victims of ragging



## **PROMOTE RESPECT:**

Foster an environment of mutual respect and inclusivity

# What constitutes Ragging?

**Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:**

**Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.**

**Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.**

**Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, torment, or embarrassment to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.**

**Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts, or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.**

**Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.**

**Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.**

**Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm, or any other danger to health or person.**

**Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, or public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.**

**Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority, or superiority by a student over any fresher**

**Any act of physical/mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the grounds of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence, or economic background.**

## How to Approach?

If any student is getting ragged, or if any student, teaching, or non-teaching staff notices an incidence of ragging, they can register a complaint through any of the following ways:

**01**

Inform (orally or in writing) any of the members of the Anti-Ragging Committee of the college

Drop a written complaint in the Complaint Box placed outside the Principal's Office

Call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline 1800-180-5522 (24\*7 Toll-Free)

One can also register an anonymous complaint. One must, however, avoid this option because without knowing the details it becomes difficult to take any action. **CONFIDENTIALITY WILL BE MAINTAINED, IF THE COMPLAINANT DESIRES.**

# **Administrative Action in the Event of Ragging**

**The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established, award to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:**

**Suspension from attending classes  
and academic privileges**

**Debarring from appearing in any  
test/examination or other  
evaluation process**

**Debarring from representing the  
institution in any regional,  
national, or international meet,  
tournament, youth festival, etc.**

**Rustication from the institution for  
periods ranging from one to four  
semesters**

**Withholding/withdrawing  
scholarship/fellowship and other  
benefits**

**Withholding results**

**Cancellation of admission**

**Expulsion from the institution and  
consequent debarring from  
admission to any other institution  
for a specified period.**

**In case the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.**


**If any students who have obtained degrees or diplomas from Delhi University are found guilty, appropriate action will be taken for the withdrawal of degrees or diplomas conferred by the University.**

**Non-students involved in reports of ragging will be proceeded with under the criminal law of India; and will be rendered ineligible for a period of five years from seeking enrolment in any of the institutions of Delhi University.**

**It is mandatory for every student and their parent to submit an ONLINE anti-ragging undertaking at the time of first admission, and thereafter each year at the time of annual registration.**



## 1. Submit Undertaking

Go to <https://rb.gy/jgrnvf>. Fill in the required details as desired. Submit the form.



## 2. Screenshot of the Email

You will receive an email at the email address you mentioned in the form, which will have a registration/reference number. Take a clear screenshot of this email. If you do not receive the mail in your inbox, check your spam folder.



## 3. Fill in the Admission Verification form

Fill the Reference Number you received on your email in the admission verification forms
