

Report: Women's Development Cell and Gender Sensitisation Committee: 2019-2021

The Women's Development Cell and Gender Sensitisation Committee is a staff council approved Committee that aims to empower students of the college and lead a progressive life and face the challenges of the age. The committee constitutes of Dr. Santoshi Kumari (Convenor), Dr. Raj Nangia and Dr. Gitanjali Dey (members). The committee has been active throughout the two years tenure (2019-2021).

Some of the highlights of the programs carried out by the committee were: Webinar on "Empowering the Young-Creating Awareness about common Gynecological Issues in Young Women". It was organized in association with National Association for Reproductive and Child Health of India (NARCHI) Delhi State branch on 27th Jan 2021. The webinar consisted of senior doctors of Loknayaka Hospital and Maulana Azad Hospital who addressed wide-ranging issues pertaining to the menstruation and other gynecological problems amongst young women. The Session was well attended by students and faculty members of the college.

The committee participated in Online Student Orientation Programme on 26th Nov. 2020. The Committee envisioned the newly enrolled students of batch 2020-2021 about the aims, visions and programs and encouraged the students to participate in large numbers. An online session was taken by Dr. Gitanjali Dey. The presentation was made Facebook live and was well attended by students.

It successfully conducted an ICT based workshop, "New Paradigms of Digital Learning", for students of the college. It was conducted from 14th-18th Sept. 2020.
