- The combination of two Discipline specific courses cannot be changed during the course of three years.
- The number of seats in each combination of Discipline courses is limited.

- Discipline specific courses (DSC) in Semesters I, II, II and IV \&
- Discipline specific electives (DSE) in Semesters V and VI.

$\checkmark 2$ GE (2 GE in a Discipline other than Discipline I and II)
$\checkmark 2$ AECCs
