- About the course

- One of the most sought after course for building broad based knowledge of students
- Provides them a common platform for learning diverse subjects
- Prepares the students for multiple options of higher education and jobs after graduation
- As many as 22 combinations are available for students to make the **choice for two discipline courses** as per their eligibility and interest.



B.A. (Programme)

- About Discipline courses



- Students would choose a **combination of two Discipline courses (Discipline 1 and Discipline 2)** which they must pursue in all the three years.
- The combination of two Discipline specific courses cannot be changed during the course of three years.
- The number of seats in each combination of Discipline courses is limited.
- Each of the Discipline course would comprise of
 - **Discipline specific courses (DSC)** in Semesters I, II, III and IV &
 - **Discipline specific electives (DSE)** in Semesters V and VI.

- Structure (1)



The B.A. (Prog.) is of three years programme, each year divided into two semesters, thus making total of six semesters. Each semester will consist of fifteen weeks.

- **Communication**
- **Environmental Science (EVS)**

To acquire a degree in B.A. (Prog) a student must study:

- ✓ 12 CC (4 English/MIL + 4 DSC in Discipline 1 + 4 DSC in Discipline II)
- ✓ 4 DSE (2 DSE in Discipline I + 2 DSE in Discipline II)
- ✓ 4 SEC (2 SEC in Discipline I + 2 SEC in Discipline II)
- ✓ 2 GE (2 GE in a Discipline other than Discipline I and II)
- ✓ 2 AECCs
