The session was mainly for all the students for making them well about the current situation of our surroundings and society regarding the COVID-19.

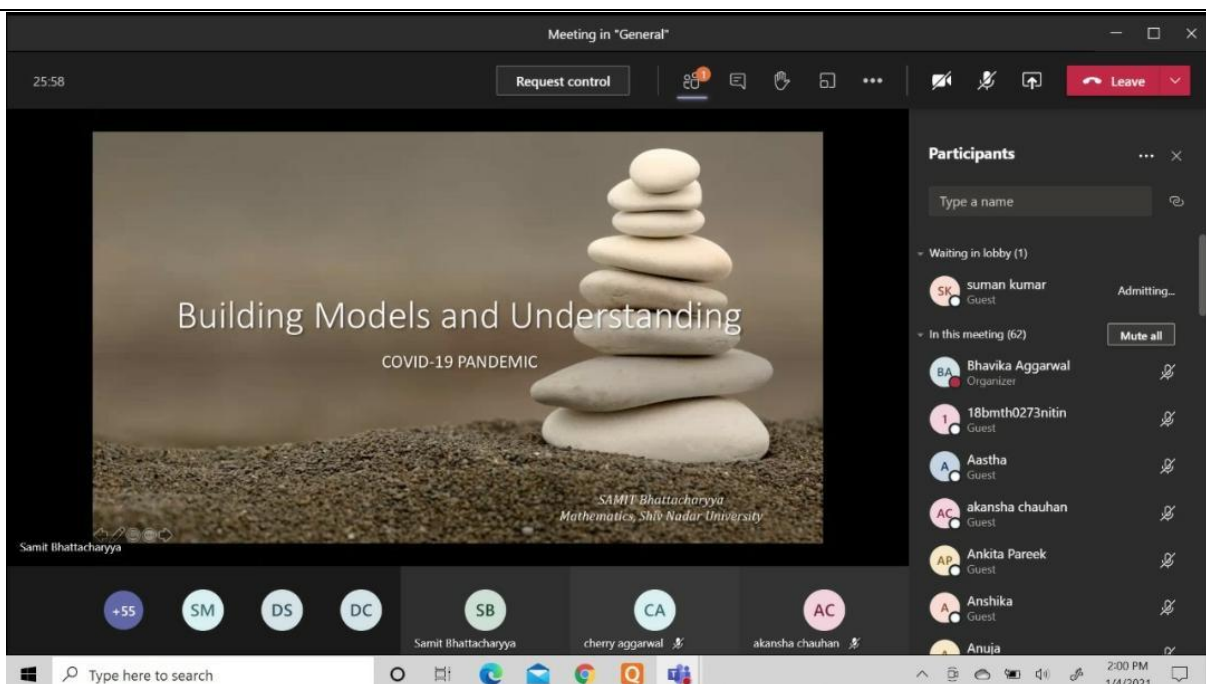
During the session, the students were told about modeling with reference to the COVID -19 like the total population which has been affected and about the recovery rate of the society.


