About the Courses:

- languages. Knowledge of a foreign language enable the students to participate in international student exchange programmes as well as enhances their employability in MNCs, BPOs, IT Firms, export houses, education institutes, tourism industry etc.
- Lakshmibai College offers Certificate and Diploma courses in Chinese, Japanese, Korean, French, German and Spanish languages. Chinese, Japanese and Korean language courses are conducted in collaboration with the Department of East Asian Studies and French, German and Spanish language courses are conducted in collaboration with the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies of University of Delhi. The College will follow the University Calendar in all matters related to academics.

More about the course:

Number of Seats:

There are 40 seats in each course. A minimum of 10 students will be required to start a course. The College reserves to withdraw a course if sufficient number of students have not registered for it. The reservation policy of the Government of India is applicable to all courses.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates who have passed 12thclass with an aggregate score of 50% are eligible to apply for all the courses.
- ► Candidates who have cleared certificate course (offered by University of Delhi) can apply for the diploma course in same language.

Documents Required:

- ► Copies of mark-sheet and pass certificate of 12th class.
- Copy of pass certificate of the concerned language (for diploma course application).
- ► Copy of caste certificate (to claim reservation).
- ► Two passport size photographs.
- ▶ Copy of any photo identity card (Aadhaar Card, Pan Card or Voter Id Card).
- Anti-ragging undertaking by the student.

Application Procedure

Application Procedure:

- Application form will be available on College website (https://lakshmibaicollege.in) from 10th August 2020.
- ▶ The candidates have to register by filling the form online by 16th August 2020.
- A registration fee of Rs 500 has to be paid online, through the portal. The registration fee is non-refundable. However, if the College is unable to offer the course for which the candidate has registered, the registration fee will be refunded.
- Once registered for a specific course, the candidates will not be allowed to change the course/language. However, the candidate may register for a preferred course within the deadline.

Admission Procedure:

- The admission process will be completed by 31st August 2020.
- Admission will be done on merit basis. These is no age limitation.
- ▶ Once selected, the candidates will be allowed two working days to pay full fees and verify certificates.

Fees Structure and Payment Process:

► Part-Time Certificate Courses: Rs 17,000

Part-Time Diploma Courses: Rs 15,000

- ► These fees do not include examination fees or study material. Examination fees will be charged separately.
- ▶ The fees can be paid online only, through the College portal.
- ► The fee is non-refundable. However, if the College is unable to offer the course for which the candidate has enrolled, the fee will be refunded.

Important Information:

- Classes are held three days a week.
- ► All classes will be held during 3:00 5:00 PM.
- A minimum of 67% attendance is required for university examination.
- ► The College reserves the right to take disciplinary action against any student violating College discipline.
- All notices related to foreign languages will be put up in the Principal's Office notice board or on college website.
- All students enrolled for the certificate and diploma courses will be issued identity cards by the College authority, only for entry into the College for classes and examinations.
- ► The University directives w.r.t. online teaching during the current academic session 2020-21 would be followed.
