Infrastructure Details

Infrastructure is the backbone of an institution and its regular up-gradation and maintenance leads to growth of the college. The infrastructure policy of the college emphasizes on arranging and managing basic infrastructure necessities for smooth conduct of classes as well as cultural and academic activities for all the stakeholders. In the last five years the college has worked concretely towards enhancement of its infrastructural capacity for the students as well as the faculty and non-teaching staff. From the building of eight classrooms (Porta cabins) with a spacious Toilet block to the development of Creche by renovating annex block near the Principal's bungalow; executing electrical restructuring by laying new cables underground to constructing new sewer line in the campus; installing solar panels of 76.8W to the opening of Open Gym with MPLAD Fund are among the major developments. Apart from this, the notable steps in infrastructure include fully furnished waiting shed, construction and shifting of admin block, opening up of Vishvakarma Bhawan (a two storey structure behind the library), development of outdoor canteen area with boundary and pavement, construction of open stage and pavements for cultural programmes, aluminium partition in courtyard areas and at other places, creating medical room, girls common room and five other rooms for different purposes. Further rainwater harvesting system has also been installed in the college premises.

Curricular and Co-curricular activities

Classrooms, technology enabled learning spaces, seminar halls, tutorial spaces, laboratories, herbal garden, specialized facilities and equipment for teaching, learning and research etc. are available for curricular and co-curricular activities.

LABORATORIES

Apparel Design and Construction Lab (Fully Air Conditioned)

Apparel Design and Construction (ADC) has three laboratories at Lakshmibai College. ADC lab with 15 workstations each fitted with a stitching machine on state of art table fitting. Lab is well lit and fully air-conditioned. There are number of textile testing equipment in the lab viz. Crease recovery tester, with a white board and three mannequins. Lab is equipped with eight wooden stools and sixteen high stools for the theoretical discussions.

The Dyeing lab has a capacity of eight students with six burners, 3 gas cylinders (with cylinder cage and gas pipeline), dyes, auxiliaries and utensils for dyeing.

The Printing lab has a big padded table, two cupboards, with number of wooden blocks, printing paste, squeegees, trays and sponges etc. to accommodate around eight students at a time.

Food Technology Lab

Food Technology (FT) Lab spanning nearly 900 square feet area is a recently renovated state-of art, well lit and ventilated lab with a capacity for 24 students. The extended part at the back is used for practical discussion classes.

There are granite clad six large work counters and a long service counter - all fitted with mica covered wooden cupboards and drawers as well as electricity points. Each counter has a stainless steel sink with drainboard and six display cupboards/boards are mounted on the walls.

The lab is well equipped with Tanita body composition analyser SC 240 and SECA stadiometer, Toshiba studio photocopier, HC laser jet M1005-MFP, industrial digital oven-cum-dehydrator, LG double door refrigerator (310 L), infrared moisture balance, analytical balance, furnace, 12 double gas burners, 16 gas cylinders (with cylinder cage and gas pipeline), plenary cake mixer, autoclave, refractometers and ample food processing tools, utensils and glass ware for analytical purposes.

COMPUTER LABS (FULLY AIR CONDITIONED)

There are many fully equipped computer laboratories in the college.
