Vol. II, dated July 15, 2002, and is registered under the Societies Act XXI of 1860 with the Government of NCT, Delhi.

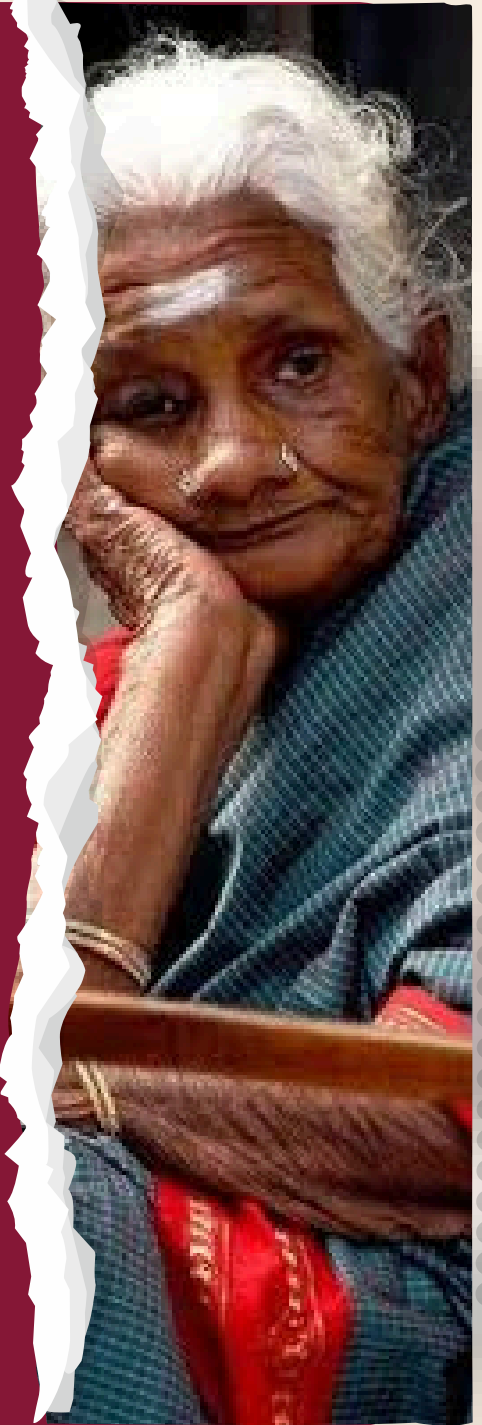


# Concept Note

- After the acceptance of the abstract, the contributors are required to send their full Paper not exceeding 5000 words including tables and figures. The text should be double-spaced 12 point. Times New Roman font with 1.5 inch all side margins on all side and 1.15 Line Spacing . The Deadline of the full paper submission is 18th September 2025. - The cover page should contain the title of the paper, author's name and brief details including the designation, e-mail and contact numbers.

- Authors would have to certify that the material is unpublished, as well as original. It is the responsibility of the authors to obtain permission to reprint previously published matter with copyright restrictions.
