STRUCTURE OF B.A.(PROGRAMME) SANSKRIT :-



The B.A. (P) SANSKRIT programme is of three years programme, each year divided into two semesters, thus making total of six semesters.

The programme includes:

- Core Courses (CC) - all compulsory courses
- Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)
- Elective courses - Ability Enhancement Elective Course (AEEC)/Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)
 - Discipline-Specific Elective (DSE)
 - Generic Elective (GE)

To acquire a degree in Sanskrit a student must study:

-12 CCs, - 02 AECCs - 02 AEECs/SEC - 06 DSEs

and thereby earn a minimum of 120 credits.
